AR - CONSPIRACY

Los Angeles and New York were advised on 1/30/63 that ALEX CAMARATA advised SF 2550-C-TE that in 1947 CAMARATA took a trip to Los Angeles with JOHN MISURACA, PETE MISURACA and MADELINE GRECO, a daughter of JOHN MISURACA. They took this trip to pick up a member of the organization who CAMARATA identified only as FONTANA. CAMARATA told the informant that FONTANA had shot a factory owner and JOHN MISURACA came from the East with his daughter MADELINE to bring this man, FONTANA, to Pennsylvania to hide him out, using MADELINE as a decoy. CAMARATA stated that FONTANA was a member of the organization and he was contacted through a "GIAMONA" who had a restaurant in Los Angeles.

On 2/2/63 SF 2550-C-TE advised SA ROY L. ERICKSON that he visited with ALEX CAMARATA during this date and CAMARATA was talking over former activities in the organization. The informant mentioned FONTANA in an effort to secure his first name and was told that FONTANA is presently in the East. CAMARATA told the informant that FONTANA "did away" with a man in July, 1937, this man being named FRANCIONI (phonetic) who ran a clothing factory in New York or Newark. He stated that FONTANA was arrested at this time and there was a woman witness. The organization allegedly learned of the woman witness through a police officer named GRICASI (phonetic) who was head of a flying squad. This man contacted JOHN MISURACA and told him that the witness was the mother-in-law of a CHARLIE FERUGGIO who was an attorney in Newark and had been disbarred. CAMARATA stated that they called
