On April 11, 1965, in Torreon, Coahuila, there was  
a meeting to observe the 46th Anniversary of the assassination  
of EMILIANO ZAPATA on April 10, 46 years ago. This meeting  
was staged by the PCM in the background, with the CCI as  
front organization, for the purpose of presenting the ten  
points handed down from the First National CCI Ordinary  
Congress held January 6 to 8, 1965, in Mexico, D. F. The  
meeting held in the USCE Hall in Torreon, was attended by  
some 50 or more individuals, including: (c)

ARTURO ORONA spoke and his remarks were largely dedicated to the memory of EMILIANO ZAPATA. He also spoke of the ten CCI points, but in a superficial manner. (c)

This meeting was devoted to the sending of protests against recent police and government raids and repressions in Mexico City against the offices of "La Voz de Mexico" and of the FEP, the PCM, and the CCI resulting in arrests there of ~~RAFAEL JACOBO~~, ~~JOSE VIESCA~~, ~~ARNOLDO MARTINEZ VERDUGO~~, ~~MANUEL TERRAZAS~~ and other leaders. (c)

Source furnished his notes on the above happenings, placed on the reverse of a four page circular dated March 10, 1965, from the National Executive Commission of the JCM, published and circularized on the subject of "Questions of Our Student Work." (c)

He also furnished a typewritten, anti-government poem, "A Morelos," on a letterhead of the "Federacion de Estudiantes Campesinos Socialistas de Mexico," Club de Orientacion Politica Ideologica "Lazaro Cardenas del Rio" at the Santa Teresa Normal School, written by School Director, ~~TEORORO AGUILAR BERMEA~~, of Santa Teresa.
