AT MIAMI BEACH, FLA.

1. Will attempt to obtain any handwriting specimens of purchasers of the Lake Surprise property listed as being owned by ABRAHAM BRUNO so that it can be compared with the known handwriting of the subject.
2. Will identify ROBERT R. GAFFINAL current owner of property at 320-84th Street.
3. Will identify the 975 Corporation, as set out in this report as well as the officers, incorporators, etc., since it is possible that this is a front company for the subject.
4. Will determine if subject is currently staying at the Golden Nugget Motel or Apartment 8, 320-84th Street.

AT MIAMI, FLA.

1. Will attempt to identify person referred to by PH 269-C as "Senator" MORRIS as set out in reairtel and in this report.
2. Will consider attempt to determine person with enough political influence in Dade County, Fla., to swing contemplated trash deal and compare his description with that furnished by PH 269-C.
3. Will contact logical informants concerning their knowledge of the contemplated Trash Collection set up in Dade County, Fla.
4. When questioning CI's ascertain if they have any knowledge of subject being in Miami Area, when he was there, who was with him and the nature of his business while there.
5. Will attempt to identify any businesses that subject is connected with in the Miami Area.

22. Will during the course of the investigation attempt to obtain handwriting specimens of the subject.
23. Will report results of trash cover on subject's residence, 934 Snyder Avenue.
24. Will check with the following Philadelphia Confidential Informants for any information or additional information that they might be able to furnish concerning the subject; PH 251-C, PH 269-C, PH 467-C, PH 468-C.
25. Will also request a check with any logical Potential Criminal Informants who might be in a position to furnish information on the subject.
26. * Will interview Detective Sergeant RAYMOND MURPHY, Philadelphia Police Department, concerning his knowledge of the current and past activities and associates of BRUNO.
27. * Will contact PH 489-C regarding the \$100,000 that he said he owed BRUNO as a result of his losses in the numbers business.
28. * Will examine the income tax records of ANGELO BRUNO currently being obtained by the Bureau and report the pertinent information contained therein.
29. * Will identify Attorney GARFIELD LEVY.
30. Will contact Post Office Substation covering the subject's address to determine if his mail is being delivered there or if it is being forwarded.
31. Will, through other investigation being conducted, determine the current activities of MARIO MAGGIO, son of Philadelphia Top Hoodlum MICHAEL MAGGIO. There is no indication that he is in the rackets.
32. Will consider interviewing RICHARDSON DILWORTH, Mayor of Philadelphia, regarding his statement that three Philadelphia Magistrates were allied with BRUNO in 1954, one of whom was Magistrate JOSEPH J. MOLINARI, convicted on January 16, 1954 of Subornation of perjury.
