Enclosed are articles from the 9/21,26,28/63 and 10/1/63 issues of "Paese Sera" pertaining to NICOLA GENTILE'S relations with La Cosa Nostra. Additional articles will be forwarded as received.

On 10/3/63 Doctor ARISTIDE MANOPULO, Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy, advised that the Italian police have still not definitely located GENTILE. As soon as GENTILE is located, MANOPULO will telephonically advise this office and consideration will be given to interviewing GENTILE.

As noted in referenced Rome cable of 10/3/63, the Italian Parliamentary Anti-Mafia Commission (IPAMC) is continuing its work. In fact, while Legat, Rome, was discussing this matter with Doctor MANOPULO on 10/3/63, MANOPULO received a telephone call ordering him to make available to the IPAMC the Italian National Police files on CHARLES "LUCKY" LUCIANO (Bufile 39-2141), FRANK/COPPOLA, and one SALVATORE LA BARBERA.

Rome Office files contain a clipping from "Il Messaggero," a Rome daily Italian language newspaper, which reveals that FRANK COPPOLA was expelled from the U.S. at some time in the past assibeing undesirable. Rome Office indices are negative regarding SALVATORE LA BARBERA.
