This refers to report of your Los Angeles,
California office dated June 8, 1966 with attached transmittal
slip dated June 19, 1966.

2. The fingerprints of ROSELLI, as supplied,
have been searched through our files with negative results.
Your fingerprint form is returned herewith, appropriately
stamped on the reverse side, for record purposes.

3. The name John ROSELLI with aliases was also
searched through our registries with similar results. There
was one positive trace on a Phillip SACCO of 16 Hastings Street,
St. Catharines, Ontario, charged under the Customs Act on 24 Oct 63
by our Niagara Falls Detachment, our file No. 63 HQ-58-0-456.
His date of birth is shown as 27 Jan 29 and it would therefore
appear that he is not the same person as the file subject. We
have not instituted enquiries to determine the possibility of
him being a relative and will have same conducted only if you
feel they are warranted.

- (1) Report from our Digby, Nova Scotia Detachment dated 18 July 66 covering the interview with Mrs. Maynard Burton ROSENCRANTS (note spelling correction) and other relatives of the late Irene MORO.

2. I contacted Rosie Ellen ROSENCRANTS (Mrs. Maynard Burton ROSENCRANTS, D. B. 3 MAY 1888 this date. She is presently living with her daughter, Florence May DARRES (Nee ROSENCRANTS) who appears to be about 60 Yrs. of age. Both ladies could not remember much about Michael MORO's activities in the U.S.A., but were sure that he had no business attachments in this province outside of the buying and selling of antiques on one occasion. Irene MORO, met Micheal MORO when he was selling antiques, and they were married around 1934. None of the family knew very much about MORO at this time, but they informed me that he was born in Italy, and had been brought to the U.S. by his parents as a young boy. Neither of the ladies knew that he had lived in Buffalo N.Y. After the marriage, Micheal MORO came to Bear River N.S. nearly every summer, accompanied by his wife, and on occasions his brothers Albert, and Harry MORO. While in Nova Scotia, they never travelled around, and usually spent about two months here on vacation. Mr. and Mrs. MORO moved to Phoenix Arizona shortly after their marriage and on the advise of his doctor a doctor CUNNINGHAM, who was practising in Chicago about 1936 and is now believed deceased. While in Chicago, moro operated a barber shop, which his brother took over, after he left for Phoenix. Albert MORO was still operating this shop up to 1945 but his present business is not known. His last residence was in Berwin Illinois.

3. When MORO moved to Phoenix Arizona, he operated the Roseveld Tavern, the Venice Cafe, and the Italian Gardens. He lived on Ocanto Drive, Phoenix, and was well known in that area. Florence May DARRES, visited with him for two winters, in 1938 and 1939 as she recalled, and also worked as a waitress in the Venice Cafe. She stated that although none of these places had been licensed, Italian wine was always served with meals. Mrs. DARRES could not recall many of MORO's associates, but named a David GOLDBERG, who owned a jewelry store in Phoenix, ARIZ and a lawyer by the name of WHITNEY. He also had dealings with Micheal LANZO, who was an employee in the printing office.

A lawyer by the name of "SARACA" also visited MORO on occasions, and he also travelled to Detroit on several occasions to see him. Mrs. DARRES stated that she could not recall any business dealings beside the places of business MORO had established. She stated that MORO was always surrounded by friends whom she did not know. In 1949, Mrs. MORO (Irene) came to Bear River alone, as the climate would not permit Micheal MORO to come back to this area due to a bronchial condition. Irene was subsequently murdered by Myron Randolph SELIG over a dispute between them that does not appear to hinge on anything to do with Micheal MORO or his associates.

4. After his wife's death, MORO re-married, but he kept this marriage a secret where it concerned the ROSENCRANTS, and it was not until after his death on 10 APR 65 that Rosie ROSENCRANTS received a letter from MORO's second wife. A Christmas card dated 12 DEC 64 was received by Mrs. ROSENCRANTS from MORO, and it was post marked Pomona California. The letter Mrs. ROSENCRANTS received from his wife had the return address 550 Webster St. Pomona California on it. Nothing has been heard from Mrs. MORO since then.

5. Micheal MORO had three brothers, and one sister. They are Albert MORO, last known address Berwin Illinois, Harry MORO, Berwin Illinois, Tony MORO, whereabouts unknown, and Annie (Mrs. Frank) CAPPERRELLI, who's husband worked in the City Hall, Chicago, about 15 Yrs ago. Albert and Harry were both barbers when they were known to Mrs. DARRES and Mrs. ROSENCRANTS.

6. Insofar as this investigation relates mainly to John ROSELLI, neither Mrs. DARRES, or Mrs. ROSENCRANTS recognized the name or any of the aliases. Neither had ever seen ROSELLI, and they did not recognize the photographs which I showed them. Through conversation with Mrs. DARRES however it was learned that MORO employed one Victor STEWART (STEWART) as a bouncer in his establishments in Phoenix. The latter, she stated appeared to be a very close friend of MORO, and that she was told that he belonged to a police force in Phoenix. Mrs. DARRES stated that she had no reason to question this explanation, and it does not appear to be information of any significance.

7. As far as can be determined at this time, MORO was not well known to either of the two ladies interviewed. They could not supply accurate dates, and in most cases attempted to guess when certain incidents happened. These dates have been reported but may not be accurate. I feel that if MORO was engaged in questionable transactions, his relatives were not aware of same. Photographs are being returned herewith.
