On February 15, 1967, SD 1064-C-TE advised that he and JIMMY FRATIANNO and some of the other members (of Los Angeles La Cosa Nostra (LCN) family) whom he did not identify, have furnished JOHN ROSSELLI with numerous complaints regarding FRANK DESIMONE's lack of leadership in running the family, and that eventually DESIMONE will be called back to Chicago for an appearance before representatives of the commission. ROSSELLI will present the charges in an effort to get DESIMONE deposed as family boss. Source stated that DESIMONE will try once or twice successfully to keep from going back to Chicago, but on about the "third order" from the Chicago boss, he will have to go back and answer the charges. The informant said the biggest problem now in the Los Angeles family besides the lack of leadership, was that all of its members are becoming old and will die off and no new blood is being brought in. He felt that there are only three or four persons now living in Southern California who could even qualify for membership and that in order to revitalize the Los Angeles family, they would have to import young members from the East.

With regard to JOHN ROSSELLI's arrest by the sheriff in Las Vegas for failure to register as an ex-con, source stated this was a bitter blow to ROSSELLI and that the word is out that the sheriff was acting on higher orders. He indicated that if they find out where those orders came from, "Someone may get hurt" (The interviewing Agents received the impression that if anyone in the Jewish mob in Las Vegas is responsible through political connections in local government or otherwise for having ROSSELLI roused, there will be retribution by the family).

LA 4412-C-TE on 12/29/66 furnished information that he and his wife spent Christmas Eve at the residence of Mr. and Mrs. ~~JOSEPH LANDOLFI~~, FBI No. 67686. After dinner, ~~JAMES ROBERT IANNONE~~, aka ~~Danny~~ Wilson, came in.

LANDOLFI told WILSON that prior to making a trip back East, they were questioned at their residence by the FBI concerning JOHN ROSSELLI, one ~~PARIGI~~, and FILIPPO SACCO.

LANDOLFI said the FBI asked him if he knew a FILIPPO SACCO and he had told them, "No". LANDOLFI's wife then said to WILSON, "You know who FILIPPO SACCO is, don't you? That's JOHNNY ROSSELLI". WILSON answered yes as though he knew, however, he made no further comment and informant does not know whether or not WILSON previously knew the true identity of ROSSELLI.

On 4/27/67 SD 1064-C-TE advised that in recent conversations with PAPA JOHN PRIZIOLA of Detroit, and JOHN ROSSELLI of Los Angeles, he learned that the Detroit LCN family has refused to allow the Chicago LCN family to purchase the unassigned 15 points in the Frontier Hotel. The Detroit family still has the 15 points and the Chicago family leaders are angry at Detroit LCN family leaders for not allowing them to share in the Frontier Hotel. *mich.*

On 5/25 and 6/6/67, SD 1064-C-TE advised that JOHN ROSSELLI of Los Angeles is handling West Coast matters for the Chicago family and has been handling the Chicago family's attempt to obtain 15 points from the Detroit family in the Frontier Hotel in Las Vegas.

Source said he believes JOHN ROSSELLI was in Chicago the week of May 29 to June 2, 1967, as he was unable to contact him in Los Angeles and knows he was not in Las Vegas.
