On 5/31/61 PG 612-C advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH III:

Prior to the primary elections on 5/16/61, GABRIEL MANNARINO and his benchmen were meeting about once or twice a week with political workers during evening hours in Memorial Park, New Kensington, Pa. This park has only one road that leads in and out, and an unusual number of cars were observed entering and leaving. Since the GABRIEL MANNARINO-backed candidate, incumbent New Kensington Mayor RAYMOND GARDLOCK, lost the nomination, there has been a marked diminution in the number of cars going to Memorial Park but GABRIEL MANNARINO has been observed to enter the park on two occasions alone in his car.

There is some talk in New Kensington that although GARDLOCK lost the party nomination for Mayor in the primaries, the GARDLOCK-MANNARINO forces are thinking of conducting a campaign to get voters to write in GARDLOCK, or some other hand-picked candidate, in the general election in November, 1961. SAMUEL MANNARINO, who backed EDWARD ZALESKI against
