On Saturday, 6/24/61, SAM MANNARING, while at the Bonfire Restaurant near Leechburg, Pa., said that it was a real blow to lose NORMAN ROTHMAN, Miami, Fla., who is a top-flight Cuban contact-man; JOSEPH "RED" QIORDANO of New Kensington, Pa., who is a first-rate fence; and even DANIEL "SPEEDO" HANNA of Arnold, Pa., who is very efficient as a gambling dealer and "Strong-arm" enforcer collector. MANNARINO said the loss of these men would create some hard-to-fill openings. For instance, to take HANNA's place, two men were considered so far. JOE HORGAN and AL SPISANO, both of New Kensington, but while either man would make a fair dealer, neither was physically or mentally constituted for strong-arm work.
