On July 16, STANLEY SCHACTER, U. S. Customs, Miami, advised SA CHARLES A. RHEW that the boat undergoing repairs by MANOLO AGUILAR at the Harbor Marine Boat Yard was under surveillance by that agency. He added that according to reports received by his agents, work was progressing very slowly on the boat, and that AGUILAR might be short of funds. SCHACTER said AGUILAR did not appear to be in any hurry to make a trip, and that he estimated it would take at least another two weeks before the boat could be put in condition to travel. He said he had not seen AGUILAR in his office for about three months
