Enquiries through Bertie Township Police Department, Ridgeway, Ontario revealed that Mildred MAHONEY, who resides on Victoria Avenue, R.R. #2, Ridgeway, is the wife of Walter J. MAHONEY, Attorney, Marine Trust Building, Buffalo, New York. It was also learned that Walter J. MAHONEY is a brother of William MAHONEY, State Senate Majority Leader of the State of New York.

2. Sgt. R. SHULTZ, Bertie Township Police, who is a close friend of the MAHONEYs, advised that Charlotte MOYER is a divorcee from Philadelphia who visited Mildred MAHONEY at Ridgeway during July 1962, having met the MAHONEYs at a race track in Florida. According to SHULTZ, Mildred MAHONEY will be leaving for Florida within the next week and will not be returning to Canada until the summer of 1963. It is felt that Mildred MAHONEY would supply any information desired to your Bureau, however she was not interviewed due to the nature of this enquiry.
