ReBuairtel 3/27/62 requesting developments re BRUNO's contact with Phila. Municipal Judge ADRIAN BONNELLY.

Information originally developed re BRUNO's contact with BONNELLY was through PH 623-C\*. From PH 269-C it was ascertained that BRUNO's associate MITCHELL COHEN did not go to Florida where BONNELLY is known to be vacationing. COHEN, according to this informant, is closely associated with BONNELLY. It was apparent COHEN was being used to contact Judge BONNELLY.

Inasmuch as COHEN did not travel to Miami for possible rendezvous with BRUNO and ultimate meeting with Judge BONNELLY, no open inquiries were made Phila. re BONNELLY's address in Florida.

PH 623-C\* indicates BRUNO returned Phila. 3/23 or 24/62 and since return has not mentioned any meetings in Miami.

Phila. will be alert for any further developments re BRUNO's activities while in Florida and will keep the Bureau advised.
