ANGELO BRUNO, AKA; AR. DAILY RADIOGRAM. WA FILE 92-2717 AND PHILADELPHIA FILE 92-444.

PH 614-C-TE STATES THAT JOHN (CASABLANCA) SIMONE, CARL (PAPPY) IPPOLITO, IGNATIUS DENARO, FRANK MONTE AND PHILLIP TESTA HAD DINNER TOGETHER APRIL 24. MITCHELL COHEN CONFERRED WITH ANGELO BRUNO CONCERNING THE MIXUP IN THE PAYOFF NUMBER, 547 OR 587, FOR APRIL 24. IT WAS DECIDED THEY WOULD PAY OFF ON NUMBER 547 EVEN THOUGH THE TRACK SHOWS THE NUMBER TO BE 587.

PH 623-C\* CONFIRMED SIMONE AND IPPOLITO'S VISIT TO BRUNO APRIL 24. IT APPEARS THAT A LOCAL WARRANT IS OUTSTANDING FOR FRANK SINDONE, WHOSE WHEREABOUTS IS KNOWN TO BRUNO AND OTHERS AT PENN JERSEY VENDING, INC. HOWEVER, BRUNO INSTRUCTED A FRANKIE LNU TO INFORM SINDONE THAT THE LOCAL POLICE WOULD PICK HIM UP IF HE IS ON THE STREET AND SUGGESTED THAT SINDONE REMAIN IN A ROOM FOR A LITTLE WHILE LONGER.

PH 614-C-TE BELIEVES IPPOLITO AND SINDONE ACCOMPANIED OTHERS TO VISIT PHIL TESTA'S WIFE, WHO IS HOSPITALIZED. ALSO, THE ZIGANETTE CARD GAME HAS BEEN SUSPENDED.

BRUNO CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.
