ADMINISTRATIVE

By airtel, dated 6/22/62, captioned "ANGELO BRUNO, aka, AR" (Bufile 92-2717; Philadelphia file 92-444), Philadelphia Division advised that on 6/15/62, PH 591-C* learned in a conversation that date, between ANGELO BRUNO, PETE MAGGIO and PAT MASSI, that it was stated by MASSI that, as regards a trip he had made to Pittsburgh, Pa., he found out that "KELLY is the caporegime" and "his father-in-law is the Under." It is noted that KELLY undoubtedly refers to GABRIEL MANNARINO, whose father-in-law, FRANK AMATO of Braddock, Pa., has long been a leading figure in Western Pennsylvania racket activities, but is now ostensibly in retirement.

During the period of this report, a close liaison has been maintained with Special Agents of the Intelligence Division, IRS, Pittsburgh, who are conducting investigation concerning subject. Also, close liaison has been maintained with Departmental Attorney JOHN J. MULANEY, who has been assigned into Pittsburgh to work on the MANNARINO cases, and who has recently conducted a Federal Grand Jury inquiry into the MANNARINO operations.
