ReBulet, 1/28/63, captioned, "THE CRIMINAL COMMISSION, ET AL; ANTI-RACKETEERING - CONSPIRACY" *General file*

In November, 1962, JOSEPH VALACHI identified subject as a member of the LUCHESE "family".

NY indices reflect information received in 1944 that one CHARLEY PRUNES was a big shot in the lower East Side around Mulberry and Hester Streets. He reportedly controlled gambling and other rackets and was reported to be a leader of a gang in that area. No further information contained in NY files.

The records of the NYCPD were checked concerning captioned individual with negative results.

Former NY 3864-C-TE advised on 3/20/63, that subject was unknown to him.

The Newark Division advised by letter on 8/27/63, that their indices do not contain any identifiable information re subject.

Newark informants, NK2251-C&, NK 2319-C\* and NK 2327-C, advised subject unknown to them.

If information is received identifying subject, appropriate investigation will be conducted as set out in reBulet. This case will be placed in a closed status until such information is received.
