NOOPSIS OF FACTS:

BORIS MORROS returned to New York City from Europe 10-13-48. MORROS had numerous meetings with JACK SOBIE in Europe after return of CNDI LA 3198 to U. S. Considerable information set out relative to JACK and MYRA SOBIE and their past and present activity in Soviet espionage. MORROS and SOBIE met ALEXANDER MIKHAILOVITCH KOROTKOV at Geneva, Switzerland 8-23-48. KOROTKOV has as superior PYOTR RISSILIVITCH REDOTOV who has direct access to BERIA and STALIN. KOROTKOV, according to MORROS, gave MORROS "a bad time," trying to test MORROS as to his loyalty to the Soviets and criticizing his wife's pro-American attitude. Thereafter followed a discussion of the television company to be used as a cover for Soviet espionage. Capitalization of company has been changed from \$250,000.00 to \$300,000.00, and money is to be forthcoming on SOBIE'S return to U. S. in mid-December. Information set out relative to further meetings of JACK SOBIE, KOROTKOV and MORROS. MORROS left N.Y.C. and arrived Los Angeles 10-22-48. Left L.A. for N.Y.C. 11-10-48. Met with MYRA SOBIE 11-15-48 and arranged future meeting 11-21-48. MORROS upon interview has admitted dealings with Soviets 1935 on return from a trip to Europe and meeting ZUBILIN in about 1936 when ZUBILIN told him he was working in Germany on undercover Nazi work. Information regarding activities and individual contacts of MORROS set out.
