CUBAN PATRIOTIC UNION

On July 26, 1967, MM T-1, a source who has been in contact with Venezuelan government officials in the United States, advised that he had learned from Enrique Tejera Paris, Venezuelan Ambassador to the United States, of a conversation he had with Carlos Vicente Hurtado on that date. Hurtado is registered with the United States Department of Justice listing his foreign principal as the Embassy of Venezuela.

During the conversation, Tejera asked Hurtado if he had seen the article appearing on July 24, 1967, and written by syndicated columnist Virginia Prewett. According to Tejera, the article contained a number of "idiotic" statements and he was curious to determine Prewett's source for these statements. He specifically wanted to know where Prewett heard that "Venezuela has a build-up for the Cuban Patriotic Union." In response to a question posed by Tejera, Hurtado stated that he knew Prewett but had not seen her for years.

"The Washington Daily News," a daily newspaper published in Washington, D. C., on July 24, 1967, contained an article by syndicated columnist Virginia Prewett. This article is as follows:

\*"VENEZUELA AROUSED"

"Venezuela is getting into position to retaliate directly for Castro's guerilla warfare against its democratic regime.

"If Venezuela is irritated enough, we'll take direct action," two top Venezuelan official personalities have told me.
