MM 492-S, whose identity and background are well
known to the Bureau, formerly worked at the Constancia
Sugar Mill in about 1929 when he knew ALEJANDRO SANTAMARIA
as a very young boy. He actually had no contact with him
or his family since that time and ALEJANDRO SANTAMARIA
sought out MM 492-S in order to see if he had any friends
in the American Consulate in Madrid, Spain, who could
possibly expedite the issuance of visas to his relatives
to come from Madrid to the United States.

MM 776-S never had any contact with ALEJANDRO
SANTAMARIA but like all former members of the Cuban National
Police and Special Investigative Squads in Cuba, he knows

the background and the notorious pro-Castro and procommunist activities of HAYDEE SANTAMARIA and her family. Persons contacted by him regard ALEJANDRO SANTAMARIA as opposed to CASTRO and the entire CASTRO regime. In fact, he appears to be bitter because his second cousin, HAYDEE SANTAMARIA, extended so little help to the relatives of ALEJANDRO SANTAMARIA in their efforts to leave Cuba.

The report submitted by MM [815-S] gives a complete description and lineup of that side of the family comprising HAYDEE SANTAMARIA CUADRADO and her brothers.

Copies of the enclosed letterhead memorandum are being furnished locally to INS and CIA which actively participate in the processing which determines the admissions of Cubans at the Caribbean Admissions Center, Miami, Florida.

UACB, ALEJANDRO SANTAMARIA GONZALEZ will be contacted directly by a Special Agent of the FBI, in order to determine if he is able to furnish any current information concerning the family of HAYDEE SANTAMARIA CUADRADO and in order to be kept informed of the arrival in the United States of the subject's daughter, AURORA DE LA CARIDAD SANTAMARIA TORRES, and her husband, TOMAS FELIPE MUNOZ GONZALEZ, so they may be interviewed directly for all information concerning HAYDEE SANTAMARIA CUADRADO and her family. The possibility will be borne in mind that ALEJANDRO SANTAMARIA GONZALEZ may be in a position to have potential as a PSI, dependent upon the results of the interview with him.
