Although the points made by the New York Office in re New York airtel were well taken, Bureau believes that it would be to our greater advantage at this time to proceed with the operation outlined in reBuairtel (X(U)

The Ad Hoc Committee (AHC) has been operating for several years and its contact with Sue Frank, although very encouraging, is not critical to its continued successful operation. We are presented with a unique opportunity to disrupt the activities of Sue Frank as well as to tarnish, not blacken, her image with the Chinese. It is not anticipated that the Chinese will lose all confidence in Frank, but in the future might demand tighter control over her activities. Tighter control implies increased contacts, directly or indirectly, by the Chinese and this would work to our advantage as well as to the advantage of the AHC should Frank in fact care to confide in the AHC regarding her relationships with the Chinese.

## NOTE:

It was suggested to New York that we direct an anonymous letter to a contact of Sue Frank in Peking. This would be an anonymous letter written by an individual who was a member of a Canadian peace group which visited China in 1966 and was in contact with the individual believed to be the Sue Frank contact in Peking. The letter would point out concern of the writer and Sue Frank over the purges of the Caucasian community residing in Peking and closely associated with Frank. New York has been instructed to prepare the text of the anonymous letter.

Buairtel of 6/21/68, states "The Bureau believes it is important the AHC informants establish contact with her (SUE FRANK) before her departure in view of the intelligence potential and also because the HC could benefit from her travel if she contacts Chicoms abroad."

Accordingly, NYO recommends that the suggested anonymous typewritten letter to T'ANG Ming-chao not be prepared. (X)
