According to the informant, DE CARLO has the "Indian", "Leech" and "Panels" operating this game for him. The informant said the game picks up players in NYC, but does not know where or by whom.

The informant related the game is played at the "transfer station", and at night. The game is played either above Gorman's (ph) Liquor Store or diagonally across the street from Gorman's, upstairs, where a drugstore used to be located between a cafeteria and a bar.
