Newark is not aware that ANTHONY PROVENZANO has any interests in a labor consultant firm. Newark has no information regarding negotiations by A & P with the Teamster's Union in the New York area. In the New Jersey area, warehousemen of A & P are represented by Newark's Teamster's Local, but it is believed that they negotiate their own contract. This local is represented by JOSEPH PECORA, who has been convicted on an LMRA violation.

*Atlantic and Pacific Tea Company*

Rebairtel dated 9/25/64 captioned "Anthony Provenzano, aka, "Tony Pro", LHMA - III." Caption of this matter is being changed in view of the allegation that a consultant firm was hired by A & P to deal with the Teamsters Union which would indicate the possibility an employer made payments to the consultant firm for the benefit of Provenzano, union official, in violation of LHMA.

Neither of the field offices to which this communication is directed should disseminate any copies of LHMA enclosed with rebairtel and the Bureau will not disseminate LHMA to the Department at this time.

Pittsburgh should discretely determine the identity of the labor consultant firm mentioned in LHMA enclosed with rebairtel. However, no contacts with the A & P or the union should be made and no outside investigation should be conducted. It is suggested Pittsburgh informant (PG 501-C) may be contacted for this purpose if Pittsburgh deems it feasible. In addition, similar discrete inquiry should be considered to ascertain whether a national contract as described in LHMA has been ratified.

After the identity of the alleged consultant firm is determined, arrangements should be made for information to be secured from established sources (Dun & Bradstreet or credit unions) in an effort to determine whether, in fact, the consultant firm is owned by Provenzano as alleged. When these attendant facts have been secured to round out this matter reported by an informant, Pittsburgh should
