Re Bureau letter to Detroit dated 4/9/64.

On 5/15/64 Dr. JOSE CUETO (CSDE 895-S) advised SA JAMES E. MC CANCE that he has heard of the organization known as Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE). He stated that he believes that this is an anti-CASTRO organization and that he has contributed some money to it, along with two other individuals. One was a man named FELIX MUNOZ, 18471 Meyers Road, Detroit, and the other was Dr. PEDRO BERDAYES, M.D., 11087 11 Mile Road, Warren, Michigan. He said that the three of them went together and contributed a sum totaling \$92.00 to JURE and that he believed the contribution was to assist in the purchase of arms for Cuba.

It is to be noted CUETO had furnished no previous information concerning this contribution, however, when asked concerning it, there was no hesitation on his part to furnish the above information. He stated that it is his desire to furnish any reasonable assistance that he can to work against FIDEL CASTRO.

CUETO advised further that FELIX MUNOZ had received a solicitation for the contribution to JURE from Los Angeles, California, and that MUNOZ had suggested the contribution that was made. He repeated that he had not contributed \$92.00 but that the contribution was as previously stated, one of \$92.00 from the three individuals.

Dr. CUETO advised that in April of 1963 he had contributed \$50.00 to an organization known to him as Comandos "L". He said the address of this organization and the place to which he had mailed his contribution was Post Office Box 66, Riverside Station, Miami, Florida. He said that his contribution had been acknowledged by a form letter from Comandos "L" signed RENE AGUILERA, Director, Relaciones Financieras. He said that this contribution was made by him for the same reason that he has made other contributions in the past, because he believes it to be an anti-CASTRO group.

CUETO stated that ADOLFO GRAUPERA, 8001 Chalfonte, Detroit, had not made any contribution with him to JURE; however, he had heard that GRAUPERA had made some contribution to JURE. He added that he did not know whether GRAUPERA's contribution was made singly or as part of a group contribution.
