ANTI FIDEL CASTRO ACTIVITIES. ^{INTERNAL SECURITY-} IS-CUBA.

ON NIGHT OF JUNE TWO, SIXTYFOUR, HARVEY SUMM, OFFICE OF CUBAN

AFFAIRS, U.S. STATE DEPT. MIAMI ADVISED HE RECEIVED INFO FROM U.S. COAST GUARD, MIAMI, THAT EIGHT INDIVIDUALS CONSISTING OF FIVE CUBAN AND THREE AMERICANS WERE PICKED UP BY A BRITISH GUARD SHIP AT ANGUILA KEY, BRITISH BAHAMAS, ON JUNE ONE, SIXTYFOUR. MIAMI CONTACTED GREGG BENTLEY, NIGHT JUNE TWO, BAHAMIAN POLICE, NASSAU WHO CONFIRMED THAT EIGHT INDIVIDUALS IDENTITIES UNKNOWN HAD BEEN PICKED UP AT ANGUILA KEY ALONG WITH A QUANTITY OF ARMS AND EQUIPMENT AND WERE BEING TRANSPORTED TO NASSAU BY A BRITISH GUARD SHIP WHICH ALSO SEIZED THEIR TWENTYFIVE ^{FOOT} BOAT. THESE EIGHT INDIVIDUALS EXPECTED TO ARRIVE NASSAU MORNING OF JUNE THREE.

BENTLEY THEN EXPECTS TO OBTAIN COMPLETE DETAILS, IDENTIFYING DATA, AND WILL FURNISH RESULTS TO THIS OFFICE.

AT ELEVEN PM JUNE TWO, SIXTYFOUR, MR. SUMM ADVISED THAT ^{U.S. COAST GUARD} ~~USCG~~, MIAMI, HAD RECEIVED MESSAGE VIA RADIO FROM BRITISH GUARD SHIP THAT THE EIGHT INDIVIDUALS PICKED UP AT ANGUILA KEY ARE AS FOLLOWS: JUAN DIAZ, ISRAEL MORRELL, MANUEL MARTINEZ, FLAVIO GONZALEZ, ARMANDO LASTRA, ANDREW ST. GEORGE, THOMAS DUNCAN, AND MARTHA BARRAS.
