ROSSELLI not known to have returned to Los Angeles since he left in his automobile on 3/29/63, for Las Vegas.

LA 4129-C advised that on 3/26/63, ROSSELLI came to Perino's Restaurant with a man unknown to informant. At Perino's, ROSSELLI and his companion joined ALBERT PARVIN and JOE SLATE who were accompanied by four girls who informant did not know. Informant thought the four girls might be "chorus girls" from "Slate Brothers", a night club on the "Sunset Strip" in Los Angeles. PARVIN is the subject of an Anti-Racketeering investigation in the Los Angeles Office. He is a part owner of the Sands and the New Frontier hotels in Las Vegas.
