July 13, 1963, which represent the north coast of Cuba, in order to embarrass the United States. No information which would substantiate the CIA report has been received to date. It is noteworthy, however, that as set out in this report, DUQUE and a friend were picked up on the beach at Palm Beach, Florida on July 17, 1963, after their boat had capsized, and upon interview, DUQUE claimed he had left Miami on July 13, 1963 on a fishing trip. While DUQUE and his friend had some food supplies, a rifle and a pistol, and a battery radio, it was not believed they were in any position to have set up a broadcasting station, as this was not a transmitting radio.

This does not preclude the possibility, however, that DUQUE was en route to a rendezvous with another boat for this purpose, but that circumstances caused the meeting to fail.

This report has been classified SECRET since it contains information from a CIA release so classified.

supporters of his organization already engaged in active opposition to the CASTRO regime inside Cuba.

DUQUE also stated he has been attempting to raise money for this purpose both in the United States and Puerto Rico and that he expected to continue to do so. He indicated that his success in this connection has been relatively limited and that financial resources are his principal problem.

On June 23, 1963, Dr. ORLANDO BOSCH, General Coordinator of DUQUE's group. 2019 W. Flagler Terrace. Miami, advised that DUQUE and his group are interested in obtaining arms for their people in Cuba but to the best of his knowledge, have no plans to make raids against Cuba or against shipping off the coast of Cuba in the immediate future. BOSCH claimed DUQUE has neither the money nor equipment necessary for such operations, although he is attempting to raise funds for the purchase of arms for the Cuban underground.

BOSCH mentioned that just three or four days previously, DUQUE had been visited by representatives of the Immigration and Naturalization Service and presented with a "Notice of Prevention of Departure," which, according to BOSCH, limited DUQUE to travel within the area of Dade County, BOSCH said that in view of this he did not believe DUQUE was preparing to make an attack against Cuba.
