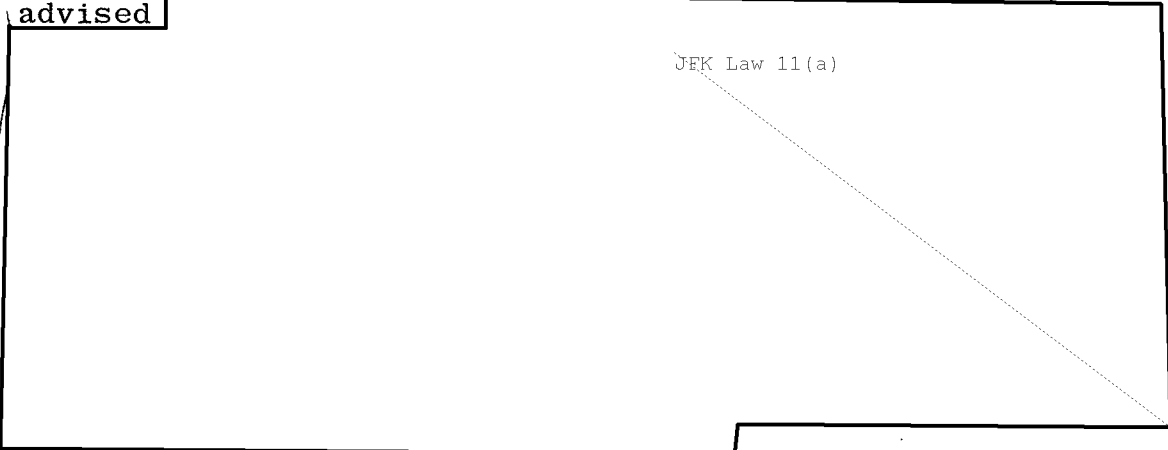

On December 29, 1961 and January 3, 1962 PCI LARRY PARKER visited the Black Magic Bar but observed no gambling activities at this barroom in the afternoon or evening of the above dates.
