PD, for questioning were ANGELO BRUNO, PHIL TESTA, FRANK NICOLETTI, FRANK SINDONE, JOHN CAPELLO, FRANK LASCALZO and RALPH SCHWARTZ. To date Commissioner LEARY has not received full report of action by Inspector BRENNAN. PH 614-C-TE reported that all above individuals / were found by Inspector BRENNAN at 740 Christian St. on the afternoon of 9/20/63. Inspector BRENNAN was apologetic, telling subjects he had "pressure from above" which forced him to take action. According to informant, individuals were taken to the REC-64 Bureau Phila DWB: ERG 3 Sent. Special Agent in Charge
