Re New York airtel dated 6/7/68.

On 6/12/68, NY 5593-C-TE was contacted regarding a meeting informant had with ANGELO BRUNO of Philadelphia, JOSEPH COLOMBO and DOMINICK GALILEO, both of New York, on 6/6/68, at the House of Chan, New York City. Informant stated that the above meeting lasted approximately 40 minutes and consisted entirely of preliminary talks concerning distribution of an automatic shoe shine machine which the informant controls. BRUNO and COLOMBO expressed interest and it appeared from the conversations that if agreements could be reached, 10 of the machines would be sent to Detroit, 10 to Philadelphia, and 10 to Miami. Informant expressed a desire to deal only with the Miami area and to eliminate Detroit and Philadelphia. At this time there was no reaction to this request by informant. Informant stated that it would be extremely costly to ship the machines to these areas and that he felt he did not wish to assume such an expense. Informant, during recent trip to Miami, Florida, was in contact with JOE MANGONE, a vending distributor in Miami. MANGONE was described by informant as a "cousin" to ANGELO BRUNO and MANGONE would handle the distribution of the machines in Miami.

Informant stated that no specific agreements were reached and a subsequent meeting would be held for the purpose of further exploring distribution of the automatic shoe shine machines.

On 6/18/68, informant stated that a meeting was held on that date at the House of Chan and attended by informant, BRUNO, COLOMBO and GALILEO.

Informant stated this was a continuation of the meeting held on 6/6/68, and lasted approximately 30 minutes. Agreements were reached to eliminate Detroit, as informant reiterated his opposition to dealing with individuals in that area. Preliminary agreement was made on distribution of the machines to the Philadelphia and Miami areas as these areas appeared to hold the most interest for BRUNO, COLOMBO and GALILEO. BRUNO strongly recommended the name of John's Vending Company, 29th and Mc Kean Streets, Philadelphia, as the company to handle the distribution of the machines in that area, and he further indicated that he would hope to control the distribution in the Miami area through his "cousin. COLOMBO did not appear to take an active part in the conversation at this meeting and after the meeting ended, informant and GALILEO left together. During this time GALILEO expressed his extreme displeasure about meeting such individuals as BRUNO and COLOMBO in public and indicated that he was strongly resentful of contacting such individuals, and that this was the last meeting. Informant advised no further meetings have been planned, however, pertinent information received concerning the above will be furnished to the Bureau and interested offices.

Also observed in the restaurant at 2:45 p.m. by SAS PETER J. OBERNESSER and DANIEL MAGENNIS was ANIELLA DELLACROCE, underboss of the GAMBINO "family". He was accompanied by two unknown white males thought to be of Italian extraction. Both of his companions appeared to be around 60 - 65 years of age. These three persons were seated several tables away from the table where COLOMBO and the others described above were seated. There appeared to be no connection between the two groups. DELLACROCE and these two individuals left the restaurant at 3:00 p.m.
