FUTURE PLANS

On August 3, 1964, MM T-4, a Federal agency which conducts intelligence investigations, reported having received information from a trained observer with access to a wide variety of Cuban exiles, that on August 2, 1964, FRANK FIORINI heard that a combined sea and air strike against Cuba was being prepared by BOSCH of the MIRR for August 3 or 4, 1964, but was delayed for lack of a pilot and an aircraft. It is to be noted that FRANK FIORINI is a United States adventurer who is well acquainted with BOSCH and some of his associates. (S) (u)

On August 24, 1964, MM T-3 reported that LAREDO RODRIGUEZ of the MIRR disclosed that he is now attempting to locate a twin-engine airplane suitable for another raid against Cuba. LAREDO is also attempting to locate a pilot for this operation. The objective will be to drop bombs on certain unidentified targets in Cuba. LAREDO indicated that money is no problem in this operation. (u)
