Re New York airtel to Bureau, 12/20/60 and New York letter to Bureau, 1/17/61, resetting out a lead for the Miami Office to interview Dr. LUIS CONTE AGUERO who had previously offered to provide a "prospectus" of his organization.

Newspaper articles which appeared in Miami newspapers in February and March, 1961, reflected that Dr. LUIS CONTE AGUERO was making a tour of various Latin American countries speaking on behalf of the FAC and of the Frente Revolucionario Democratico (FRD) against the communist government of FIDEL CASTRO.

On April 17, 1961, MM 724-S advised that CONTE AGUERO had entered Cuba clandestinely several days previously in order to participate, as a radio broadcaster, in anti-CASTRO invasion plans, which were initiated on the early morning of April 17, 1961. CONTE AGUERO's last known address in Miami was 1434 N. W. 29th Street, telephone NE 4-1155.

It appears that the lead to interview CONTE AGUERO is now obsolete and this case is being placed in a closed status.
