No information has been received concerning the
formation of a Cuban Government in Exile, as such, since
relet.

The following, however, does have some bearing on the
activities of the anti-Castro movement in Uruguay, which may
be of interest.

On 6/21/61, ~~ACS~~ [EDUARDO PEIXOTO] informed that the
Congress for Liberty and Democracy referred to in relet was
held as scheduled in Montevideo, Uruguay, between June 1 and
4, 1961. The inaugural program held at the Ateneo in Montevideo
was attended by some 700 persons, many of whom had to stand
during the affair. The principal delegates attending the
conference were students from the interior of Uruguay, as
well as from Montevideo itself.

Dr. LUIS CONTE AGUERO, Cuban anti-Castro leader who
came to Uruguay to attend this Congress, was elected its
Executive President. CONTE AGUERO has made an extremely
favorable impression in Uruguay, not only on the occasion of
this visit but also during a visit made earlier in 1961. In
the opinion of ~~ACS~~ [PEIXOTO], CONTE AGUERO is an able and per-
suasive speaker and has given impetus to the anti-Castro
movement through his appearances.

Delegates from Argentina, Chile, Bolivia, Peru,
Mexico and El Salvador also were present at the Congress.
