Djeffouh Naceur, who resided at 52 rue Gay-Lyssac, Paris 5. FRANCE (S)

While in London, during August, 1968, she was to visit Al Dahir, an Iraqi, who resided at 40 Peckarmans Wood, Crescent Wood Road, London S.E. 26. ENGLAND (S)

At Paris, it is requested those individuals residing in Paris, including the Franco-Chinese Association of Friendship, be identified and any information of a security nature regarding them be obtained. (S)

At London, it is requested Al Dahir be identified and any information of a security nature regarding him be obtained. (S)

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
