Logical informants and appropriate law enforcement officials in Jacksonville and Duval County have been alerted to allegations that [MIRR was making plans to sink an unidentified merchant ship in Jacksonville on 8/24 or 25/65 by attaching a mine to this vessel.] Security office of the U. S. Navy Installation at Mayport, Florida, was also alerted.

Lt. Commander A. G. TAYLOR, Office of Captain of the Port, U. S. Coastguard, Jacksonville, furnished a list of vessels which at the present time will arrive during the period of 8/23-25/65 in Jacksonville as follows:

Commander TAYLOR indicated there may be other ships arrive and he will promptly alert the Jacksonville Division.

Commander TAYLOR also advised that the steamship IRISH POPLAR, Iranian registry, will arrive 8/23/65 at Kings Bay, Georgia, to be handled by the Blue Star Shipping Corporation. This company handles a large amount of dynamite and other explosives. There is also located at this port an Army installation handling explosives. Commander TAYLOR was of the opinion that a logical target of the MIRR would be a ship carrying explosives.

Jacksonville is maintaining close contact with the Commander for further developments concerning this matter.

SAVANNAH

AT KINGS BAY, GEORGIA:

Requested to alert appropriate law enforcement officials concerning the possibility that the steamship IRISH POPLAR may be the target of the alleged planned activity. Commander TAYLOR has stated in the event it is necessary to contact the Blue Star Shipping Corporation that he would recommend direct contact with Mr. MARION MARTIN, President, whom he believes to be completely trustworthy.
