NY 5824-S\* advised on 8/21/59 that the subject had been invited by the Communist Party of China to go to China to work on the "Peking Review". NY 5824-S\* stated that she planned to leave for China in 10/59.

BA 975-S\*<sup>(S)(u)</sup> advised on 8/8/61 that early in 5/61 the subject and her husband were in Moscow having gone there recently from a trip to China.

NY 4112-S\* advised on 8/20/63 that the subject is known to and has been in contact with TANG Ming-chou a person reported to be head of political intelligence, as it pertains to English speaking countries, for the Government of China.

NY 4047-S\* has advised that on numerous occasions the subject has had meetings with MILTON K. ROSEN, head of the Progressive Labor Movement and with FRED JEROME the editor of "Challenge" the official publication of the Progressive Labor Movement. Many of these meetings took place in the subject's home.

NY 4047-S\*<sup>1</sup> advised on 11/10/64 that the subject stated that she reads Hsin Hua practically every day. Hsin Hua is the official news agency of the government of Communist China.

On 9/25/63 CSNY LENORE SERKANIC advised that the subject had recently stated to her that CHIANG Kai-shek is like a voice from the grave and compared him to a ventriloquist's dummy who sits on Uncle Sam's knee and is manipulated by him.

NY 3809-S\*<sup>(S)</sup> advised on 9/21/64 that the subject flew to Milan, Italy on 8/11/64. On 8/28/64, after her return to the U.S., she told her mother-in-law that she spent about two weeks with her father in New Jersey. This would indicate that her trip to Milan was clandestine. ~~(S)~~
