INTERNAL SECURITY - CHINA

Reference is made to memorandum of this Bureau dated May 6, 1965 at New York and captioned "Leo Huberman, Internal Security - China."

According to reliable sources, Huberman will be visiting Cuba in the near future and contemplates attending a conference of Asian and African nations to be held in Algeria in June, 1965. It is suspected that Susan Heiligman Frank will accompany Huberman to Algeria. Your Agency has had previous interest in Huberman and Frank and you have been provided with information concerning them by this Bureau.] (S) (u)

It is requested that your Agency attempt to cover the activities of both Huberman and Frank during their attendance at the Asian-African Conference in Algeria. Please advise this Bureau also of any information you may obtain concerning Huberman's travel to Cuba.] (S) (u)

NOTE: Both Huberman and Frank are strongly suspected of being Chinese Communist Agents, having had contact with a highly placed Chinese official in London. New York has requested coverage of their activities in Algeria.] (S) (u)
