Re Chicago letter 6/3/65, to NY which requested NY to furnish daily contacts of SUE WARREN FRANK to Chicago in order to devise, if at all possible, a plan by which CG 5908-S could reasonably contact this person.

Through a coincidental combination of circumstances, it now appears we have a unique opportunity to put CG 5908-S in contact with SUE FRANK. FRANK has been in contact with the Algerian Mission to the UN and on 6/15/65, through Western Union, she made reservations for a double hotel room in Algiers for 6/27/65. This means she should be leaving NYC on or about 6/26/65 which is the day CG 5908-S plans to go to Albania. If NY can find out what plane she is taking, we may be able to put CG 5908-S on the same plane. In fact, they could end up on the same plane with no planning on our part.

FRANK is going to attend an Asian-African conference in Algiers and also she may possibly be going there to meet TANG MING-CHOU who is reportedly head of political intelligence in English speaking countries for the Chinese People's Republic. The NYO is attempting to determine TANG'S whereabouts during this period through CIA. For Chicago's information, TANG wrote to SUE FRANK in 1963 and asked her to recommend people to come to China. He said she knew the procedure, the working conditions, and the kind of people they want. All SUE had to do was prepare a letter of recommendation and the Chinese would take care of the rest including expenses. It could be that this is the reason CHARLES LOMAN (see below) is in contact with FRANK. (u)

The NY file on SUE FRANK does not contain any information showing she visited Chicago during the time CG 5908-S thinks he met her in Chicago. A review of appropriate Chicago files, however, may show she was there. Five photographs of SUE FRANK are enclosed for Chicago. After the photographs have been exhibited to CG 5908-S, [S] and they are no longer useful to Chicago, they should be returned to NY. These photographs, generally speaking, are a good likeness of FRANK. (X)

Also of interest to Chicago is the fact that CSNY 3 advised on 5/13/65, that SUE FRANK received a money order through Western Union on that date in the amount of \$200.00 from CHARLES LOMAN of Chicago.

On 6/16/65, according to NY 4047-S*, LOMAN called SUE FRANK "from a long ways away" and said he may see her on the July 4th weekend. She said she would be gone then. He also said he is sending 50 (dollars). LOMAN continued by saying there is so much to talk about and of course the phone is no good and the mail is bad too. LOMAN said there are a couple of people he could have talked to her about, he just did not want to write about them. LOMAN wished her a good trip, said he would see her in the Summer one way or another.

Chicago is requested to comment on what they believe the reasons are for LOMAN'S contact with FRANK. Chicago may also wish to determine whether CG [5908]-S has [] had any dealings with [LOMAN] and whether [LOMAN] would be able to furnish information about informant to FRANK. (S)

Chicago advised in referenced letter that they wished to maintain a complete background of SUE FRANK and requested NY to submit a list of individuals most frequently contacted by FRANK. This will be done by separate communication.

Chicago may not feel this is an appropriate time to put CG [5908]-S in contact with FRANK. Yet, we may never have a better opportunity. Chicago should promptly submit the... plans they have in mind for furthering [the Ad Hoc operation] through contact with FRANK for Bureau approval unless Chicago prefers not to have informant contact FRANK under these circumstances.
