On March 16, 1966, T-1, a confidential source abroad, furnished information as follows:(3)


Subject arrived at London Airport from New York on January 13, 1966, and departed England for an undisclosed destination on January 25, 1966. During subject's stay in England she was in contact with the Campaign Against Racial Discrimination (CARD). During her contacts she described herself as an American civil rights worker and asked CARD to appeal to its members to send individual protests to the Mayor of New York about the trial of William Epton, who is facing a charge of inciting the 1964 Harlem riots (5)

According to T-1, CARD is a bona fide civil rights organization but it is vulnerable to influence and penetration by extremist elements. (5)
