DENNIS HARBER, white male American, while drinking in Veracruz, claimed to have plans to blow up a Yugoslav vessel known to be engaged in Cuban trade, and a German ship presently in port in Veracruz. HARBER claimed to plan to place explosives aboard ships which will be detonated by a radio device when they arrive in Cuba. He further claimed payment of \$3,000.00 by a private source in the United States to perform the operation.

Miami informant MM 639-S advised that HARBER has been in the Miami area for about two years, is a part-time language instructor, lives in cheap hotels, is a heavy drinker, and a homosexual.

Informant advised that HARBER has been on the fringes of anti-CASTRO activity for some time, but has not been seen in Miami since about the end of November, 1963; he apparently does not have the courage to handle explosives or to participate in any action against Cuba.
