Attached are the original and four copies of a letterhead memorandum containing background information concerning MIKE GEORGE HAZIDAKIS, a member of the MANNARINO organization.

In addition to background information the letterhead memorandum discloses possible violations of the Internal Revenue Code on the part of HAZIDAKIS which should be dissembated to the Internal Revenue Service, Washington, D. C.

A review of the records of the U.S. Clerk of Courts, Naturalization Bureau, Western District of Pennsylvania, mentioned in Paragraph 1, was conducted by SA RICHARD GORDON DOUCE.

A copy of the letterhead memorandum has already been designated to IRS, locally.

Records of the U.S. Clerk of Courts, Naturalization Bureau, Western District of Pennsylvania, Pittsburgh, Pa., Volume 597, reviewed by a Special Agent of the FBI on February 25, 1955, disclosed that MIKE OFORGE HAZIDAKIS, aged 22, arrived in the United States at Ellis Island, New York, on June 18, 1920, aboard the vessel "Themistocles" from Athens, Greece. The records indicated that HAZIDAKIS filed a Declaration of Intention in U.S. District Court, Pittsburgh, January 19, 1923, and was admitted to citizenship, January 1, 1925, Certificate of Naturalization Number 2212298.

Records of the U.S. Clerk of Courts, Western District of Pennsylenia, Criminal Docket, Volume 35, Page 385, reviewed by a Special Agent of the FBI on February 25, 1958, in the case of the United States vs MIKE GEORGE HAZIDAKIS and ANDY KALUMBAS, disclosed that defendants were indicted for furnishing false testimony in a naturalization proceeding on November 15, 1932, in violation of Section 23 of the Naturalization Act of June 29, 1906. The case was tried on February 17, 1933, and HAZIDAKIS was found guilty on all counts of the indictment while KALUMBAS was acquitted by order of the court. HAZIDAKIS was sentenced to two months imprisonment on June 9, 1933, and paid court costs in the amount of \$51.

Records of the Westmoreland County Jail, Greensburg, Pa., reviewed by a Special Agent of the PBI on February 24, 1958, indicated that MIKE GEORGE HAZIDAKIS was committed on June 14, 1933, after conviction in U.S. District Court, Pittsburgh, for violation of Section 23, Naturalization Act of June 29, 1906. Records disclosed that HAZIDAKIS was released after being imprisoned for two months.

In conclusion sewroe identified GEORGE LEMENIS of 57 Sentouring Street, Piracus, Greece, as the local representative of HAZIDAKIS in Greece.

A source on January 14, 1959, stated that CABRIEL MANNARING recently confided that he considers MINE MARIDAKIS his most trusted lieutenant insofer as financial matters of the Triangle Billiards Cambling Camino are concerned. Source pointed out that according to MANNARING, MAZIDAKIS maintains the books for the craps games and is noted for his accuracy in keeping records.

The same source went on to say that HAZIDAKIS recently told him that he and JOHN PONTANA received \$125 a weak from the MANNARINO operated Triangle Hilliards Gimbling Casino plus oin per cent of the take on the dice tables. According to the same source, the dice percentage sculd run so high as \$1,000 a week.

The same source who has been acquainted with MAZIDARIS for over 20 years stated that MAZIDARIS has become a very wealthy man by reason of his association with the MAMARINO brothers and during the past several years has sade a number of trips to his home town in Pirasum, Greece, and that one piece of property in Pirasus brings a rental of \$1,150 a menth.

The same source on Pobruary PA, 1950, pointed out that for the past 12 to 15 years, HAZIDAKIS has been a trusted lieutenant of the MARKARINO organization, directly responsible to GABRIEL MARWARINO. The case source went on to say that at the present time MAZIDAKIS and POWANA are supervising the Triangle Billiarde Cembling Cashao in Now Konsington and that HAZIDAKIS has the responsibility of bolding large excepts of cash and making a finel accomiting of the proceeds to the MANNARINO brothers.

The same source stated that duying 1957 HAZIDAKIS visited his wife and sen in Athens, Greece, and indicated to this source before leaving that braight remain in Greece paresheatly. The same source pointed out that several menths later after HAZIDAKIS returned from Greece he gathered from conversations with his that GAERIEL HAMMARINO either ordered HAZIDAKIS back to the United States or MARNARINO cost semeone over to bring him bak. The same source expressed the opinion that MAZIDAKIS is terrified of CAERIEL MARNARINO and only remains in high Palves Series for course of winding up with a built in his him follow GAERIEL MARNARINO a ordered.
