THAN BE DEAD OR HAVE SOMETHING HAPPEN TO MY FAMILY UNQUOTE. SAID THIS WAS THE GENERAL FEELING AMONG PEOPLE CONNECTED IN ANY WAY WITH SUBJECTS AND THAT HE WAS CERTAIN NOBODY OF ANY SIGNIFICANCE WAS GOING TO COME FORWARD WITH PERTINENT INFORMATION DUE TO FEAR OF SUBJECTS.
