NOTE: On the basis of investigation by the Bureau of Customs, subject was indicted on charges of smuggling arms and ammunition out of U. S. He was also investigated by Customs in connection with an attempted bribery of a Customs agent. Subject is reported to have been in contact with William Alexander Morgan, a Cuban revolutionary figure, and it is alleged that the Dominican General Consul in Miami gave subject \$152,000 for Morgan. Even through (C) subject may have furnished money to Morgan, Morgan has indicated he is not on friendly terms with subject. Information set forth in this letter was obtained from CV 428-C.
