It is recognized that the investigative period of this report is somewhat lengthy; however, this case is presently in the process of being presented to the Federal Grand Jury and the United States Marshal has been experiencing difficulty in locating witnesses for service of subpoenaes, and Assistant United States Attorney JAMES J. CASEY, who has been handling the presentation, has been busy with other matters and a tour of duty with the National Guard. All investigative leads have been covered immediately and it is felt that submission of an earlier report would have been for status purposes only.

DETAILS: AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

On June 1, 1965, EILEEN CURRY appeared at the office of Assistant United States Attorney JAMES J. CASEY and identified a photograph of FRANK C. TORNABENE, FBI Number 4 768 434, as being identical with the FRANKIE "T" who was associated with her in a house of prostitution on Cleveland Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

EILEEN CURRY on the same date advised that she was convicted in Cook County Felony Court on June 28, 1965, during a bench trial as keeper of a house of prostitution at 521 West Dickens Street, Chicago. She stated she received a three year prisonn sentence as a result of this conviction which she intends to appeal.

On the same date, EILEEN CURRY read and signed the statement which she made to SAs AUGUST C. KEMPFF and ROBERT L. MALONE on November 4, 1964. Her signature on this statement was witness by SAs MALONE and MICHAEL G. SIMON after Assistant United States Attorney CASEY advised her fully of her rights.

Miss CURRY advised that she is currently residing in Apartment 1 at 1750 North Wells Street, Chicago, and her telephone number there is 642-0904.

She related she would attempt to ascertain the current whereabouts of ERNASTINE LOGAN in order that LOGAN can be served with a subpoena to appear as a witness before the Federal Grand Jury in Chicago.in connection with this matter. It is to be noted a subpoena issued for LOGAN to appear before the Grand Jury was returned by the United States Marshal's Office unserved when they failed to locate her at her last known residence, 7259 South Constance, Chicago.

Mr. CASEY further advised that
and had previously appeared as witnesses
before the Grand Jury. He stated was very cooperative

On July 9, 1965, EILEEN CURRY telephonically advised that she was unsuccessful in her effort to ascertain the current whereabouts of ERNASTINE LOGAN, however, ERNASTINE's brother who is employed at the Sahara North Motel would probably be able to furnish an address for ERNASTINE.

On June 8, 1965, IC A. P. PALBICKE, Jr. caused records maintained by the Chicago Police Department to be searched for information identifiable with SAM ELIA, also known as SAM CASH. These records reflected as follows:
