Re Legat, London, letter 12/17/63, copy enclosed for New York. Also enclosed for New York are single copies of following pertinent serials in Bufile 100-437500 (Jack Perry; SM-C): Legat, Mexico City letters dated 3/14,30/62; Legat, London, letters 5/11/62 and its enclosed letterhead memorandum, 5/31/62 and 6/18/62.

New York is instructed to make every effort to tie in Jack Perry with captioned subjects [in order to logically request British for intensive coverage of Perry] without compromising NY 604-S*.

New York should be particularly alert for any foreign travel by subjects. New York note Huberman was scheduled to leave U.S. 12/18/63 for six weeks to visit Puerto Rico and England.

Legat, London, promptly alert logical sources for information regarding Huberman's contacts should he travel to England. (S)

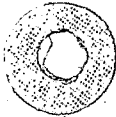
Susan Frank and her husband, Richard, are suspected of being agents for Chinese Communists in U.S. NY 694-S* advised liaison with Chinese Communists is maintained through Israel Epstein and TANG Ming-chao with headquarters in office of Jack Perry, British Communist Party member. Richard Frank and Huberman reportedly maintained liaison with TANG and Epstein.

To protect NY 694-S* we have not furnished foregoing to British. (S) New York is affording Franks intensified coverage in New York. If Bureau's investigation can disclose connection of captioned subjects with Perry, we will then be in position to request British to intensify coverage of Perry, TANG and Epstein in London without compromising NY 694-S*.

For the information of the Bureau, British Security Service, MI-5, does have a file on JACK PERRY and information re PERRY has been furnished to the Bureau by this office, Bufile 100-437590. There is no information in this office, however, to indicate that MI-5 is now aware that PERRY is in close contact with Chinese Communist elements in London. (S)

MI-5 has been recontacted re activities of subjects while in England and as of 12/11/63 Mr. STEWART MC CALLUM, MI-5, advised that they had no additional data to furnish at this time. All information known to this office coming from MI-5 has previously been furnished to the Bureau. (S)

Before proceeding further with this particular investigation, in view of information contained in relet, Legat, London suggests that no further action should be taken with MI-5 at this time and that this office await results of New York investigation which may uncover additional information from another source which would enable Legat, London to then recontact MI-5. These cases will be maintained in a pending status awaiting results of New York investigation. (S)
