Cleveland area city directories failed to reflect any person by name of GLORIA NAJI living at 682 Edgewood Road, Richmond Heights 24, Ohio.

DR. ABDUL FAHAK NAJI DR. ABDUL F. NAJI BORN 7/31/23 BAGDAD, IRAQ  
CSCV-370-S advised on January 15, 1964, that Dr. ABDUL NAJI lives at 682 Edgewood Road, Richmond Heights, 24, Ohio. Source's records reflected that telephone service was installed for him at this address during 1961, that he is employed at St. Alexis Hospital in Cleveland and his wife's name is GLORIA.

MRS. CLIFFORD MARQUARDT NAJI  
Records of the Cleveland Retail Credit Men's Company, Cleveland, Ohio, on December 19, 1963, reflected that Dr. ABDUL F. NAJI, wife GLORIA H. MARQUARDT, lived at 9507 Euclid Avenue, Logan Hotel, Cleveland, Ohio on August 29, 1961. Former residence was listed as 1277 Brainard Road, with present address as 682 Edgewood Road, Cleveland, OH.

GLORIA MILHOUSE GLORIA MARQUARDT  
His credit record from 1961 to 1963 was satisfactory.

Additional credit information reflects that Dr. NAJI was born July 31, 1923, at Bagdad Iraq and was of the Iraq nationality. He is married and has twin sons 4 1/2 years old. His wife was the widow of CLIFFORD MARQUARDT and his character and reputation were listed as favorable. Information available also reflected that Dr. NAJI was first in the Cleveland area in 1953 when he was an intern at the Cleveland Clinic and later at University Hospital both in Cleveland. He left Cleveland in 1956 and was employed as a pathologist at Brooklyn Hospital, Brooklyn, New York from 1956 to 1959 when he returned to Bagdad, Iraq.
