Re NY letters to Director 4/10/63 and 11/21/63 and Legat, London letters to Director 11/18/63 and 3/19/64.

On 8/20/63, NY 4112-S* furnished two empty envelopes, one from D. F. BOCK, Victoria Hotel, London, England and one from P. DEEGAN, Mayfair Hotel, London, England, addressed to the subject.

Legat, London by letter dated 11/18/63 stated that MI-5 could find no record of either DEEGAN or BOCK at the hotels mentioned in August, 1963. (S)

Re NY letter of 11/21/63 stated that on 10/22/63, the subject received a package from one S. RANDOLPH, Regent Palace Hotel, London, England. This package was believed to contain the war writings of MAO TSE-TUNG.

Legat, London by letter dated 3/19/64, advised that MI-5 could find no record of S. RANDOLPH at the Regent Palace Hotel during the pertinent period. (S)

All three of these communications have the following in common: all use an initial or initials and a surname; all three have the return address of a hotel in London; and in each instance no record of the sender could be found at the hotel. (S)

It is to be noted that a technique similar to the above has been recently used by other foreign intelligence services. (S) Therefore, the possibility exists that these communications may have some intelligence significance.

The Bureau is requested through liaison to request MI-5 to check back for a few months prior to August, 1963 at the Victoria and Mayfair Hotel in London for any record of BOCK or DEEGAN in order that it may be stated with some certainty that the names BOCK and DEEGAN are fictitious. (S)

The Bureau is also requested to request MI-5 to determine if any officials of the Chinese Peoples Republic were registered at these hotels during the pertinent period with particular regard to TANG MING-CHOU aka Chutong with whom the subject is known to have a relationship. (S)
