AR - CONSPIRACY

ReNKtel 2/25/64, captioned "Angelo DeCarlo, aka., AR," and Bulet 1/31/64, captioned as above.

For information New York, NK 2251-C* reported on discussion between DeCarlo, Si Rega, Carl Silesia and Sam DeCavalcante regarding death of Nick Delmore. Text of retel indicated that Delmore's death now makes DeCavalcante "boss," and mention is made that he had previously been "underboss" prior to Delmore's death.

This data, significant to discreet efforts to enlarge on information regarding additional La Cosa Nostra "family" in New Jersey. Newark expedite transmission of airtel verbatim transcript to Bureau and New York.

NOTE: During the recent past information was developed from NY 3461-C-TE that there is a 6th "family" in La Cosa Nostra in the New York area. According to this source, this additional "family" operates exclusively in New Jersey and is a small and very tightly knit group. Newark and New York were instructed to discreetly attempt to enlarge on this information and Delmore was cited as an important La Cosa Nostra leader who might well figure in the operations of such an additional group, inasmuch as to date we have not been able to align him solidly with any of New York's five "families," or with the Philadelphia "family," all of whom operate in New Jersey. ReNKtel on DeCarlo concerns a discussion in which it is stated that Delmore's death now makes Sam DeCavalcante, La Cosa Nostra member from Trenton, New Jersey, "boss." It was indicated that Delmore had made DeCavalcante "underboss" prior to his death. DeCavalcante himself participated in this discussion and acknowledge that he had been made "underboss."
