Re Bureau letter, 4/28/67, captioned "ANTHONY MUNOCO; ANTI-RACKETEERING"; and Detroit letter, dated 4/18/67, captioned "LA COSA NOSTRA; AR".

Investigation with reference to ANTHONY MUNOCO was originally initated by the Detroit Office in 11/62, on the basis of information furnished by DE 878-C-TE, to SA'ROBERT N. FITZPATRICK to the effect that MUNOCO was engaged in racketeering activities and was associated with the organized criminal element in the Detroit area. His identity, background, and associates were established, but no information was obtained indicating that he was engaged in activities in violation of Federal Statutes under the Bureau's jurisdiction.

In 9/64, information was received from the Philadelphia Office to the effect that the telephone, address book of ANGELO BRUNO, top hoodlum in the Detroit area, contained the name, address, and telephone number of ANTHONY MUNOCO and his wife, FRANCES. Background information concerning MUNOCO was submitted to the Philadelphia Office in connection with that investigation.

The case file with reference to ANTHONY MUNOCO has been re-opened and an investigation is being conducted to determine his complete background, activities, and associates. An Anti-Racketeering report suitable for dissemination will be submitted in the near future.
