because PETRELLA never does anything without AIELLO being in on a deal with him. It is to be noted that the Chez Paree is one of the better class bars or taverns in Youngstown.

CV-572-C, who is one of the owners of the Chez Paree, was contacted, and he advised PETRELLA came up with a down payment of cash to bind the sale of the business, along with one ANTHONY LATONE, who acted like a principal. Informant stated he signed an agreement for LATONE and PETRELLA to take over the Chez Paree on a long term payment basis, payable by the month, to the present stockholders of the Chez Paree. Informant stated that PETRELLA remarked that he has located a buyer for his Club 98, but did not name this person or state the deal had been consummated. Informant also stated that during the business talks, either LATONE or PETRELLA remarked about "getting some money from an Italian in Cleveland", to invest in the Chez Paree. He has no idea who this person could be or whether this remark was true or misleading.

CV-572-C also advised he was at a CV race track some time ago with a legitimate male from Youngstown, and ATELLO approached the man, who the informant refused to identify, and told him, "Give me \$100, I know you have it", whereupon the man gave ATELLO the requested sum. Informant stated he asked this man who gave ATELLO the money if he knew ATELLO, and the man said, "I want to live and if you don't give guys like him what they ask for, they'll kill you. They make their living this way."

Re: DOMINICK MALLAMO, aka., "Big Dom", and the CALABRESE ORGANIZATION

CV-544-C advised he and his brother have had three meetings with MALLAMO, and it is about settled that they will take over the operation of the C.M.A.S. Club, 19-5th Ave., Youngstown. He stated that the only outlay of capital at present is a \$500 cash bond which they have to post with MALLAMO to guarantee that there will be no damage to the equipment of the Club, and then build a small kitchen for cooking. Informant stated MALLAMO has been very good with them in that he has been most agreeable, and if there is anyone around the Club that the informant does not want, all he has to do is call MALLAMO, and he will see to it that they will be barred from

the Club. Informant further stated he just learned that MALIAMO is not actually a member of the Club. He was questioned further regarding MALIAMO, and MALIAMO told him he wants to retire from his work, but currently is holding out on closing his Workingmen's Club, E. Federal St., because he figures he will obtain some kind of settlement when the urban renewal takes over the property and demolishes the building. Informant further advised he and his brother will put an employee of their's, TONY BRUNO, as steward, in charge of the Club.

CV-278-C-TE advised on 7-9-64, that new operators, 2 Calabrese, have taken over the operation of the C.M.A.S. Club, and that one TONY (LNU) is the Club Steward. Informant advised it is his understanding that MALLAMO is the 3rd partner with the 2 Calabrese, who have taken over the Club, but that JOHN SALVATORE, aka., Scardoni, and MARIO GUERRIERI are not involved in any way in the operation of the Club.

Re: JOSEPH NAPLES, JR., aka., "Joey" - SUSPECT

Mahoning County Prosecutor CLYDE OSBORNE advised 7-2-64, that the Ohio Supreme Court turned down an application for a writ of habeas corpus on 7-1-64, filed by NAPLES, currently incarcerated in the Ohio Penitentiary, Columbus, serving two terms for promoting a numbers game and for receiving stolen property.

The Youngstown "Vindicator" newspaper of 7-3-64, in an article captioned "NAPLES TURNS TO U.S. COURT", indicated that on 7-2-64, NAPLES sought a writ of habeas corpus in the U.S. District Court, Columbus, O. In his writ, NAPLES charges that his conviction in Mahoning County Common Pleas Court was obtained "directly and solely" on evidence from an illegal search of his aged parents' home. The petition continued that the search warrant was issued without reasonable, probable legal cause on the basis of false statements by the detective who signed the complaint. Further, NAPLES was not in the house but was summoned to it and arrested there without a warrant, and as a result, he was convicted of the charges which have deprived him of his liberty without due process of law.
