Re Philadelphia letter captioned "PH 672-C-TE" dated 7/2/64.

On 6/24/64 PH 702-C* furnished details of a conversation between ROCCO SCAFIDI and FRANK MONTE. The following information is extremely sensitive and caution should be utilized in reporting the information contained herein.

For general information it is to be pointed out that PH 623-C* has previously established that FRANK MONTE and FRANK NARDUCCI were both "made" members of La Cosa Nostra in Philadelphia in 10/60. PH 672-C-TE has previously stated that ROCCO SCAFIDI was "reinstated" into La Cosa Nostra on the same night. This source said this induction ceremony took place at the Buckeye Athletic Club operated by ADAM D'OLIO. The Buckeye Athletic Club is on South 8th Street near Wharton in Philadelphia, Pa.

It is also for background information pointed out that FRANK MONTE and SCAFIDI previously committed robberies and burglaries together. The following is a verbatim transcript of this conversation in which SCAFIDI is designated as "S" and MONTE is designated as "M." Portions within parentheses are explanations to clarify the conversation.
