A SOURCE WHO IS A CUBAN EXILE AND WHO HAS FURNISHED RELIABLE
INFORMATION IN THE PAST ON JANUARY 28, 1967 ADVISED AS FOLLOWS:

ON JANUARY 28, 1967 AT 8:30 PM A RALLY WAS HELD AT THE
MIAMI STADIUM, MIAMI FLORIDA. ABOUT 14,000 CUBAN EXILES
ATTENDED. THE ONLY SPEAKER WAS DR ENRIQUE HUERTA. ON THE
SPEAKERS PLATFORM WERE REPRESENTATIVES OF COSTA RICA, VENEZUELA,
PERU, AND NICARAGUA. HUERTAS READ TELEGRAMS FROM THE MAYOR OF
MIAMI, ROBERT KING HIGH AND PRESIDENT JOHNSON. THERE WERE NO
AMERICANS ON THE SPEAKER'S PLATFORM. HUERTAS SPOKE ON UNITY
AMONG CUBAN EXILES AND ASKED SUPPORT FROM THE 21 LATIN AMERICAN
REPUBLICS.

AFTER END OF HUERTAS SPEECH ^{AT 10:21 PM} CUBAN EXILES APPEARED
AND STARTED TO UNFURL BANNERS IN FAVOR OF DR ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA.

THE HEAD OF AN INDEPENDENT ANTI COSTRO ORGANIZATION MOVIMIENTO
 INSURRECCIONAL DE RECUPERACION REVOLUCIONARIA. THEY WERE
 IMMEDIATELY ARRESTED BY POLICE AND REMOVED FROM THE STADIUM.
 BOSCH CLIMBED UPON THE SPEAKERS STAND AND TRIED TO MAKE A
 SPEECH. HE WAS STOPPED BY HUERTAS. AN ARGUMENT BETWEEN BOSCH
 AND HUERTAS FOLLOWED AND THE CROWD IN THE STADIUM STARTED
 TO BECOME RESTLESS, IMPATIENT, AND FIGHTS STARTED.

HUERTAS THEN ALLOWED BOSCH TO MAKE A PRESENTATION TO
 DR EDUARDO RITTER AISLAND, PANAMANIAN AMBASSADOR TO THE
 ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES, AND THE CROWD QUIETED
 DOWN. THE RALLY TERMINATED AT ABOUT 10:45 PM WITH NO FURTHER
 INCIDENTS.
