Title changed to show correct names of subjects Gimino and Ricciardelli as revealed by Martindale-Hubbell Law Directory. It is noted this directory shows Gimino has an office at 545 Pavonia Avenue, Jersey City, New Jersey, and Ricciardelli is located at 26 Journal Square, Jersey City.

For Newark's information, Bureau considers it extremely important that information furnished by NK 2381-C-TE concerning instant matter be disseminated to the Department and requests Newark's views as to whether such dissemination can be made without endangering the security of the source. Newark should afford this very careful consideration, as such dissemination will be made unless Newark can provide some extraordinary reason as to why this should not be done.

Absolutely no investigation or outside inquiries are to be made at this time. However, Philadelphia is requested to advise, whether, from information in its files or on the basis of personal knowledge of Philadelphia Agents, it can furnish any information as to the possible identity of the Philadelphia attorney mentioned in reairtel as the son of a Circuit Court judge. For Philadelphia's consideration, it is noted that the Martindale-

Hubbell Law Directory lists Philip P. Kalodner (born in 1930) and Robert V. Harris (born in 1932 and affiliated with the firm of Dilworth, Paxson, Kalish, Kohn and Dilks) as attorneys in Philadelphia. It is not known whether these individuals are the sons of Circuit Court Judges Harry E. Kalodner and Albert Branson Harris, respectively.

It is emphasized that no investigation should be conducted in this matter at this time; however, Newark should maintain close contact with NK 2381-C-TE and immediately advise the Bureau of any further information that may be received concerning same.

**NOTE:** NK 2381-C-TE advised that Carl Palo (described as a fence) told the informant that he has the Anthony Provenzano appeal fixed. (Provenzano, the leading Teamsters Union official in the State of New Jersey, was convicted in U. S. District Court, Newark, of violating the Anti-Racketeering Statute and sentenced on 7/12/63 to serve 7 years in jail and pay \$10,000 fine. This conviction was appealed and the appeal was argued before the Third Circuit Court of Appeals in Philadelphia on 3/12/64. No decision has been rendered by the Circuit Court as yet.)

Palo told the informant that the fix was handled through Frank Gimino, a practicing attorney in Jersey City who goes to Philadelphia every week; Ricciardelli, also an attorney in Jersey City is in on the deal and assists Gimino. These attorneys allegedly contacted the son of one of the Federal Circuit Court judges who is a lawyer in Philadelphia and who acts as liaison with the judge. The judge, in turn, is a close friend of one of the other judges and feels he can bring this other judge over to his side. At the present time the persons handling the matter in Philadelphia plan to keep moving the case to the bottom of the pile until they feel the time is right. The informant does not know how much money, if any, has been paid.

On 6/4/64, NK 2381-C-TE orally advised as follows:

CARL PALO, a fence of stolen stock certificates and similar merchandise, is known to the informant to be intimately acquainted with JOSEPH ARTHUR ZICARELLI and HAROLD KONIGSBERG.

PALO believes the informant to be one of ZICARELLI's trusted and close associates. All the information obtained by the informant has come from PALO.

PALO swears that he has the ANTHONY PROVENZANO appeal fixed. It has been handled through FRANK GIMINO, an ex-prosecutor and practicing attorney in Jersey City. He allegedly goes to Philadelphia every week. QUINIUS RICARDELLI, attorney, 26 Journal Square, Jersey City, is in on the deal with GIMINO and assists him.

These two men have contacted the son of one of the Federal Circuit Judges who is a lawyer in Philadelphia. The son of the Judge is their liaison with the judge. This judge in turn is a close friend of one of the other two judges and feels he can bring him over to his side.

At present the persons handling the matter in Philadelphia plan to keep moving the case to the bottom of the pile until they feel the time is right.
